

Actual-Size Drawings Help You Order the Right Part

The drawings that follow are actual-size outlines of the contacts you are replacing.

If you are not sure what replacement part to order, you can compare the part you have removed with the drawings until you find one that matches the size you need.

Use the same procedure to identify the replacement contact you need:

1. Go to the OEM section that corresponds to the make of the starter/contacter you are working on.
2. Find the series or model number of the contactor; if you don't know, flip through the pages until one of the contact drawings looks close to what you need.
3. Place the old contact on top of the drawing.
4. If the shape of the contact matches the drawing in all dimensions, that's the part to order.
5. If one or more dimensions are different, keep looking.
